LADDERBALL™

The throwing, winding, flipping game of family fun!

Double LADDERBALL™

The throwing, winding, flipping game of family fun!

SET-UP

Place target ladder about 25 feet away from throwing point. There can be 2 or 4 players. One player/team is blue, the other red. One set of bolas is tossed by a player, then a set of bolas is tossed by the opponent, etc.

Point Values:

- Blue bar (top bar) = 3 points
- Red bar (middle bar) = 2 points
- White bar (bottom bar) = 1 point

SET-UP

Place target ladders about 25 feet apart from each other. Players stand next to one ladder and throw towards the other one. There can be 2 or 4 players. One player/team is blue, the other red. One set of bolas is tossed by a player, then a set of bolas is tossed by the opponent, etc.

Point Values:

- Blue bar (top bar) = 3 points
- Red bar (middle bar) = 2 points
- White bar (bottom bar) = 1 point

GAME PLAY & SCORING

CLASSIC LADDERBALL

Each player throws their three bolas alternately with the other player/team. Once all bolas have been tossed, each player/team adds up the total points scored for that round. If your bola was knocked off by your opponent, those points are lost. The player/team with the highest score for that round subtracts the other player/team's score from their own and this becomes their new score. The other player/team gets no points. With each round, scores are added until one player/team reaches 21 and wins.

TEAM/PLAYER 1 lands:

- 1 on the blue bar (3 points each) = 3 points
- 2 on the red bar (2 points each) = 4 points
- Total = 7 points

TEAM/PLAYER 2 lands:

- 1 on the red bar (2 points each) = 2 points
- 1 on the white bar (1 point each) = 1 point
- 1 miss = 0 points
- Total = 3 points

Team/Player 1 had the higher score, so they subtract Team/Player 2's score from their own (7-3=4) and add 4 points to their total score.

TWISTED LADDERBALL

Twisted Ladderball is played the same way as Classic Ladderball except that the number of points for the bar that your bola lands on is multiplied by the number of times the rope wrapped around the bar. Once all of the bolas are thrown, each team/player adds up total points for that round. The first team/player to reach 50 points wins.

TEAM/PLAYER 1 lands:

- 1 on the blue bar (3 points) X 1 wrap = 3 points
- 1 on the red bar (2 points) X 2 wraps = 4 points
- 1 on the white bar (1 point) X 3 wraps = 3 points
- Total = 10 points

TEAM/PLAYER 2 lands:

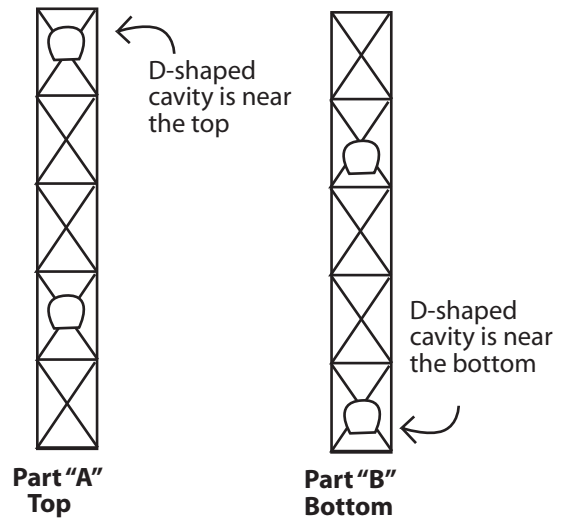
- 1 on the red bar (2 points) X 1 wrap = 2 points
- 1 on the white bar (1 point) X 2 wraps = 2 points
- 1 ball set knocked off = 0 points
- Total = 4 points

Teams/players would continue to play rounds until one team or player reaches 50 points.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

-First, locate each of the four (4) black rectangle-shaped upright parts (they have several x-shaped spacers on the inside). Take note that there are two distinctly different parts: Lay the parts on the floor with the flat side of the D-shaped connection point facing you. Notice that one part has a D-shaped cavity close to the top edge of the part (A), the other part has a D-shaped cavity close to the bottom of the part (B). Part A is the top portion of the upright, and part B is the bottom portion. Take one of each of these parts and put them together using the small upright connectors. Make sure the flat portions of the D-shaped cavities are all facing down. Do the same with the other two upright parts, to create a total of two long uprights.



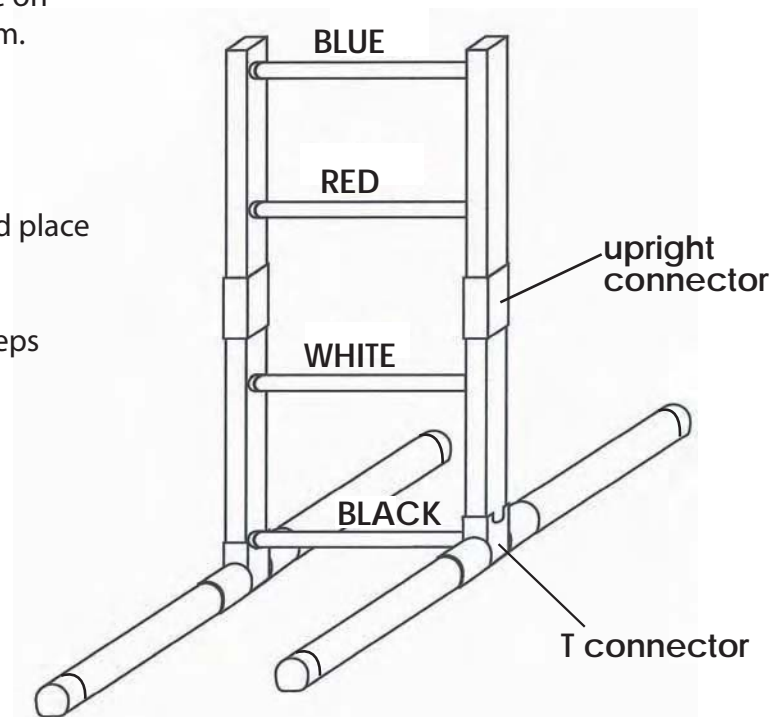
-Second, locate one each of blue, red, white and black "D" shaped bars. Make sure the black bar is the one without end caps. Insert each end of these colored bars into the D-shaped cavities on the inside of the uprights. Note: The flat part of the bars should be facing the ground, leaving the rounded side facing upward.

-Make sure to arrange the bars in the following order: blue on top, red in the middle, white next, and black on the bottom.

-Third, place the T connectors on the bottom of the uprights.

-Take the remaining four (4) black bars (with end caps) and place them in the T connector.

-If you have purchased Double Ladderball repeat these steps to set up the other Ladderball goal and you're all set!

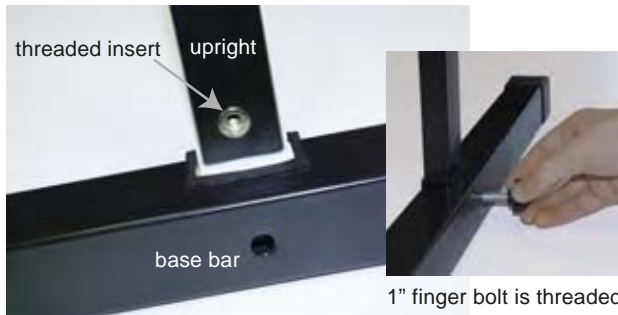

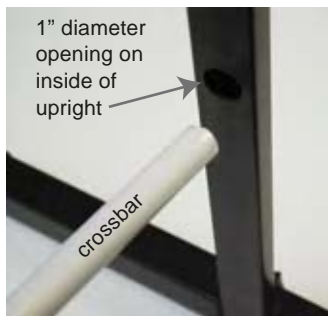

Instructions for assembly



1" finger bolt is threaded into upright from outside of base bar

Assemble base bars to uprights with 1" finger bolts. Position upright into base with threaded insert on bottom of upright positioned to the outside of the ladder. Assemble all four uprights to a base bar and proceed to next step.



1/4" finger bolt is threaded into crossbar from outside of upright

Assemble crossbars to **ONE** upright with 1/4" finger bolts. Insert white crossbar into lowest 1" diameter opening on inside of upright and thread bolt into crossbar from outside of upright. Repeat for red (middle) and blue (top). Assemble second upright to crossbars to complete ladder. Repeat process for second ladder.

Place ladders 25' apart & PLAY!
